

## Dalteparin (Fragmin) Dosing Card

DRUG ORDERED	DISPENSED
<b>VTE/DVT Prophylaxis</b>	
Enoxaparin 30mg daily	Dalteparin 5000 units daily
Enoxaparin 30mg BID	
Enoxaparin 40mg daily	
<b>Treatment Indications</b>	
Enoxaparin 40mg q12h	Dalteparin 5000 units q12h
Enoxaparin 1mg/kg q12h (Atrial Arrhythmia & Bridging Therapy)	Dalteparin 100 units/kg q12h (Max dose: 10,000 units)
Enoxaparin 1mg/kg q12h (DVT/PE)	Dalteparin 200 units/kg daily† (Max dose: 18,000 units)
Enoxaparin 1.5mg/kg q24h (DVT/PE)	
Enoxaparin 1mg/kg q12h (DVT/PE Pregnancy)	Dalteparin 100 units/kg q12h† (Max dose: 10,000 units)

†see dosing card: exception for weight >150 kg

### Renal Insufficiency (estimated CrCl < 30ml/min and not on dialysis)

- Current ACCP Guidelines recommend heparin use in patients with severe renal impairment due to higher risk of bleeding.
- DVT/VTE Prophylaxis in medical/surgical patients: Unfractionated Heparin 5000 units SQ q8h or q12h should be considered (preferred agent for dialysis) OR consider empiric Dalteparin 2500 units SQ q24h (may also consider if patient high risk for bleeding)
- Full dose anticoagulation: Weight-based Unfractionated Heparin drip per protocol

## Dalteparin Rounding Protocol

### 200 unit/kg SQ q24h

Patient Weight	Dalteparin Dose
≤ 56 kg	10,000 units q24h
57-68 kg	12,500 units q24h
69-82 kg	15,000 units q24h
83-150 kg	18,000 units q24h
>150 kg	Consider heparin infusion†

## Dalteparin Rounding Protocol

### 100 unit/kg SQ q12h

Patient Weight	Dalteparin Dose
≤ 56 kg	5,000 units q12h
57-68 kg	6,000 units q12h*
69-82 kg	7,500 units q12h
83-94 kg	9,000 units q12h*
95-150 kg	10,000 units q12h
>150 kg	Consider heparin infusion†

\*Pharmacy department will draw up and dispense

Pre-filled Syringe sizes: 2500, 5000, 10000, 12500, 15000 & 18000 units

NOTE: round to the nearest whole syringe or pharmacy department will draw up
