## ST-Elevation MI (STEMI) Protocol

Ancillary: STAT 12 Lead EKG (within 10 minutes)

**Laboratory:** STAT CBC, BMP, PT/PTT and Troponin

IV Fluids: Peripheral line #1: Start 0.9% N/S 1000ml @ 100 cc/hr

(KVO if fluid overload is suspected)

Peripheral line #2: Hep lock or 0.9% N/S @ KVO.

Medications: Aspirin 325mg PO STAT (if not already taken/given)

Nitroglycerin 0.4mg SL every 5 minutes, up to 3 doses as needed for pain relief,

hold for SBP<100

Morphine Sulfate 2-4mg IV every 5-15 minutes prn for pain, hold for SBP<100

and monitor LOC

Heparin 60u/kg IV push, maximum dose 4,000 units

Plavix 600mg PO now

Metoprolol 5mg IV push every 5 minutes x 3 doses, hold for SBP<90 or HR<60

IIB/IIIA: Reopro 0.25mg/kg IV bolus \*\* if no contraindications-see attached

\*\* Please note: No Integrilin is to be used unless instructed to do so by the

accepting cardiologist

Nursing: Record estimated height, weight and allergies

Pulse oximetry; adjust oxygen flow to obtain saturation above 95%

Remove pt's shoes, pants and underwear if possible prior to transport.
